MURDER.

A violent murder was perpetrated in the nighborhood of Greensborough, (Ala.) on the evening of Sunday the 2d instant. THE CHOLERA.

We learn from the Pittsburg Mercury that two or three deaths occurred there last week, from a disease which has been pronounced genuine Cholera: and that in Wheeling the disease had increased; fifteen cases and eight deaths, having occurred on Tuesday and Wednesday of last week.

The distinction of murder into degrees was introduced into Pennsylvania by the act of 1794; and has subsequently found favor in Louisiana, Maryland, Ohio, Virginia, &c .where the principle of our law has been adopted. The honor of originating it is perhaps ascribed to Wm. Bradford-successively a federal judge and attorney-general of this state and of the United States-who wrote his 'Enquiry in the year 1793. The penalto kill, manifested by circumstances or the use of a mortal weapon with malice prepense or aforethought; or in the attempt to perpetrate arson, or other heinous offences enumerated in the act. If the intention be not to terminate life, but merely to inflict some great corporal punishment, the offence is reduced to murder of the second degree-an offence which is punished in Pennsylvania by imprisonment.
